Recording with Your Heroes

Each instructor will be coaching and recording a song/tune with a predetermined group of 4 or 5 campers. (If you have already prepared a duet based on the way we did recordings in the past, you can totally do that in addition to the group recording.) You will have scheduled time each day to connect with your instructor/group to decide on a song and get an arrangement together. If you ask nicely, you might have the option of additional rhythm guitar, fiddle, or vocals on your recording! On the day of the recording, all the campers will gather in the studio (Andy's House) for a briefing on the recording process and then each of the groups will record their song – each group can take a couple of passes at the recording so there's no need to be nervous. Before and after the recording time, all instructors will be selling their incredible recordings and instructional materials up in the Great Room. Don't miss that!
